 - Works in raw framebuffer
 - Standalone or plugin
 - Supports free codecs

- Problems
 - Codec Patents
 - Reverse engineering is hard slow work
- Struggling Features
 - Duplicating Adobe's bugs
 - Version skew in dependant libraries
- Tech gaps
 - Flash is a crappy format
